

Time is approaching for the 2024 Annual Diocesan Appeal.

Please watch your mailboxes for upcoming donor opportunities. The breakdown of contributions and goals for each of our parishes is as follows.

St Joseph: 2 families contributed \$265.00 toward the goal of \$950 for 2023. The parish goal for the Appeal for 2024 is \$1,200 from 20 families.

St Mary: 8 families contributed \$1265 toward the goal of \$1800 for 2023. The parish goal for the Appeal for 2024 is \$1300 from 56 families.
